| 2011 | Connection     | Pittsburgh Cultural Trust                     | \$50,000     | Online processing of season subscriptions for the seven arts organizations in the Cultural District.   |

| 2014 | Connection    | Allegheny County Parks                  | \$92,167 | Allegheny County and the City of Pittsburgh established a Park Ranger program. The City and County worked together on a joint training program.  |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Carnegie Museums                        | \$60,000 | Creation of an audio guide for mobile devices, tactile 3D reproductions of Warhol art works and installation of an assistive listening system in the 120-seat theater.   |
| 2014 | Connection    | Society for Contemporary Craft          | \$60,000 | Shared full-time position of Chief Financial Officer by the Arts Finance Cohort (New Hazlett Theater, Pittsburgh Glass Center, PICT Classic Theatre, Society for Contemporary Craft and the Union Project) over a three year period. |
| 2014 | Accessibility | City of Asylum                          | \$10,000 | Assistive listening and language translation system equipment.   |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Attack Theatre                          | \$26,250 | ADA ramps, transducers, amplifiers, projectors, and wireless microphones were purchased to be used during outreach programs.   |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Mattress Factory                        | \$12,710 | Created audio guides of exhibitions for computers or mobile devices, developed Braille text visitor guides, and modified website.  |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Children's Museum of Pittsburgh         | \$35,000 | Updated website for visually impaired users, developed tactile maps and guides, updated museum signage, and developed audio tours.   |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Pittsburgh Musical Theater              | \$10,000 | Updated a wheelchair lift in the Gargaro Theater.  |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Carnegie Museums                        | \$72,273 | Modernized the Carnegie Music Hall elevator, upgraded the Museum of Art's rear entrance and entrance to the café.  |
| 2014 | Accessibility | Audubon Society of Western Pennsylvania | \$7,500  | Construction of accessible trail - a 40-foot long, six-foot wide elevated boardwalk that provides access to the pond at Beechwood Farms.   |

| 2015 | Accessibility | Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh          | \$25,000  | A platform lift and automated door openers were installed, a walkway was graded, and two rows of seats were reconfigured to provide wheelchair space at the Carnegie Lecture Hall. The Lecture Hall is used by the Library and other assets, including the Natural History Museum, Warhol, Calliope and Pittsburgh Arts & Lectures. |
| 2015 | Accessibility | Children's Museum of Pittsburgh         | \$9,250   | Purchase and install four emergency evacuation chairs in the main stairwells of the museum.   |
| 2016 | Accessibility | Union Project                           | \$20,000  | Renovation of two front lobby bathrooms to full ADA compliance.   |
| 2016 | Connection    | Pittsburgh Cultural Trust               | \$333,333 | The Pittsburgh Cultural Trust and the African American Cultural Center developed a new collaborative effort to manage and enhance programming at the August Wilson Center.  |
| 2016 | Accessibility | Pittsburgh Public Theater               | \$25,000  | Upgrades to the Public's assistive listening system with captioning and audio descriptive functionality.  |
| 2016 | Accessibility | Pittsburgh Zoo and PPG Aquarium         | \$25,000  | Purchase of interactive components and tactile signs for new exhibit, Jungle Odyssey, which opened in May 2017.   |
| 2016 | Accessibility | Greater Pittsburgh Arts Council         | \$14,638  | Purchase of two portable assistive audio technology systems which provides assistive listening (amplification of sound with headphones for people with hearing loss) for shared use by any cultural organization in the county.   |
| 2016 | Accessibility | Attack Theatre                          | \$6,000   | Purchase of specialized equipment including seating (bean bags, gym mats and portable and lightweight benches), fidget toys, floor dots, and portable lighting systems to be used in mainstage and school performances.   |
| 2016 | Accessibility | Audubon Society of Western Pennsylvania | \$60,000  | Created accessible parking and a new road to the lower level of Beechwood Farms Nature Reserve main campus.   |
| 2017 | Connection    | Three Rivers Young Peoples Orchestra    | \$15,000  | Three Rivers Young Peoples Orchestras and Pittsburgh Youth Symphony are collaborating to relaunch the chamber music program known as the Youth Chamber Connection.  |
| 2017 | Accessibility | Pittsburgh Cultural Trust               | \$6,300   | Installation of two automated doors at the Byham Theater, a 1,300-seat theater in the Cultural District.  |
| 2017 | Connection    | PICT Classic Theatre                    | \$25,000  | PICT Classic Theatre moved its office and will be performing at WQED studios for the next three years. Funding was provided for a portable seating system for the studio.   |

| 2018 | Connection    | Pittsburgh Festival Opera            | \$16,000 | Pittsburgh Festival Opera (formerly Opera Theatre of Pittsburgh) and the Pittsburgh Youth Symphony are hiring a joint marketing position. The District provided funding for one year and the two assets contributed \$24,000 toward the position. |
| 2018 | Connection    | Chatham Baroque                      | \$50,000 | Merger with Renaissance and Baroque.  |
| 2018 | Connection    | Three Rivers Young Peoples Orchestra | \$34,000 | Collaboration with Afro-American Music Institute, Mendelssohn Choir (jr), Pittsburgh Youth Symphony, Pittsburgh School for Choral Arts and Pittsburgh Philharmonic for Youth Music Pittsburgh   |
| 2018 | Connection    | Greater Pittsburgh Arts Council      | \$34,000 | Diversity capacity building program to work with 75-100 arts organizations to create long term change with organizations becoming more diverse, inclusive and accessible.   |
